We are celebrating our twins and triplets this month. Multiple births are quite common in Uganda. Often the family cannot manage because of poverty, sometimes the mothers have died in childbirth and dad needs help until the children are 3 or 4 years old. Then they can go home to him. We do assist some multiple births (often Quads) who are at home with the family with formula and clothes.

In January 2023 we had a 2 week old abandoned by his mother (who was mad) admitted that we named Ethan. This past month we have had a visit from the possible dad (waiting DNA results) and grandmother who have avidly been searching for him. A Probation Officer (child protection) led them to us. Prayerfully this is his family and they will reunite.
