This past month has been another of big change at the Home / Orphanage as our nine children who have been preparing for their move to a new home had a farewell party with cake for all the children. They are transitioning into their next step inlife. Please keep them in your prayers:- Benedict, Lydia, Mercy, Ivan, Emmanuel, Joseph, Noreen, Precious, Rebecca.

Also Victoria has made a very long journey home to her family in the village. It is a big adjustment for all these children to leave what has been their home for so long, so please pray for her to settle into her new life with all its many changes.

It is so hard to say the goodbyes but we know that it is necessary for the children to move into their future and for us to have room for other needy children.

Melissa on the left is one of the little ones who needed care from us - her mother died in childbirth. The Grandmother is not able to provide the care and protection she needs at this time.

Elizabeth at bottom left was found by a Good Samaritan who waited with her for an hour hoping for a parent to come and claim her but none did. She then went to the Child and Family Protection in the Police Department and they arranged for Elizabeth to come to us. Please keep them all in prayer.

Joram came to us via a Probation Officer and a Social Worker who had both been involved in his case. His mother is mentally III. There is an ongoing search to try and find his extended family.

Thank you for enabling us to be your hands of love extended to these beautiful children in such need. You are making a difference in a lot of lives!!
