## Dear Welcome Home Friends and Family,

It is all hands on deck to help with the washing at Welcome Home. The wash for 70 children is a mountain. **We need your help!!!!** Our 2 industrial washing machines that we have had since 2005 are no longer working at all. They need parts that are no longer available. We have tried for 2 months to get the part from the USA and also East Africa to no avail. The good news is that there are two new industrial machines available in Kampala without all the hassles of importing, taxes, duties and "expedite fees". The cost is \$24,500 installed into our laundry room. **Are you able to help with a designated washing machine gift?** Any help would be appreciated for this unexpected need.

Peter is doing well at his new home in Lugazi where Sister Sylvia who interned with us works. He had a great send off and went with his car, stroller and some toys as well as plenty of clothes. He is greatly missed as his smile and joy lit up our home.

The new ministry into the villages looking for the children at risk has been working well. (Culturally, sick children are concealed). The little girl on the bottom left was discovered 100 yards from the Lwambogo church. She had been at a village care center for an IV (Malaria?) and the IV site (a scalp vein) became infected. She is now being cared for by us nutritionally and medically to get her strong enough to have the surgery she needs. We are working with the parents to educate them for work and teach them how to better care for their child.
